Things to remember:

- Funders don't fund retrospectively.
- There are people out there to help— so ask.
- The size of the box on the application form is not indicative of how much information is required .
- Don't spend any money until you have checked if it is viable, resources are precious!
- Plan ahead!
- Remember very few funders give you 100% funding so start saving now!
- Keep trying to raise money even after you have submitted and been successful!
- Work as a team not in isolation!
- How up to date is your lease—who is the land owner?
- Remember funding changes on a daily basis— so check regularly!

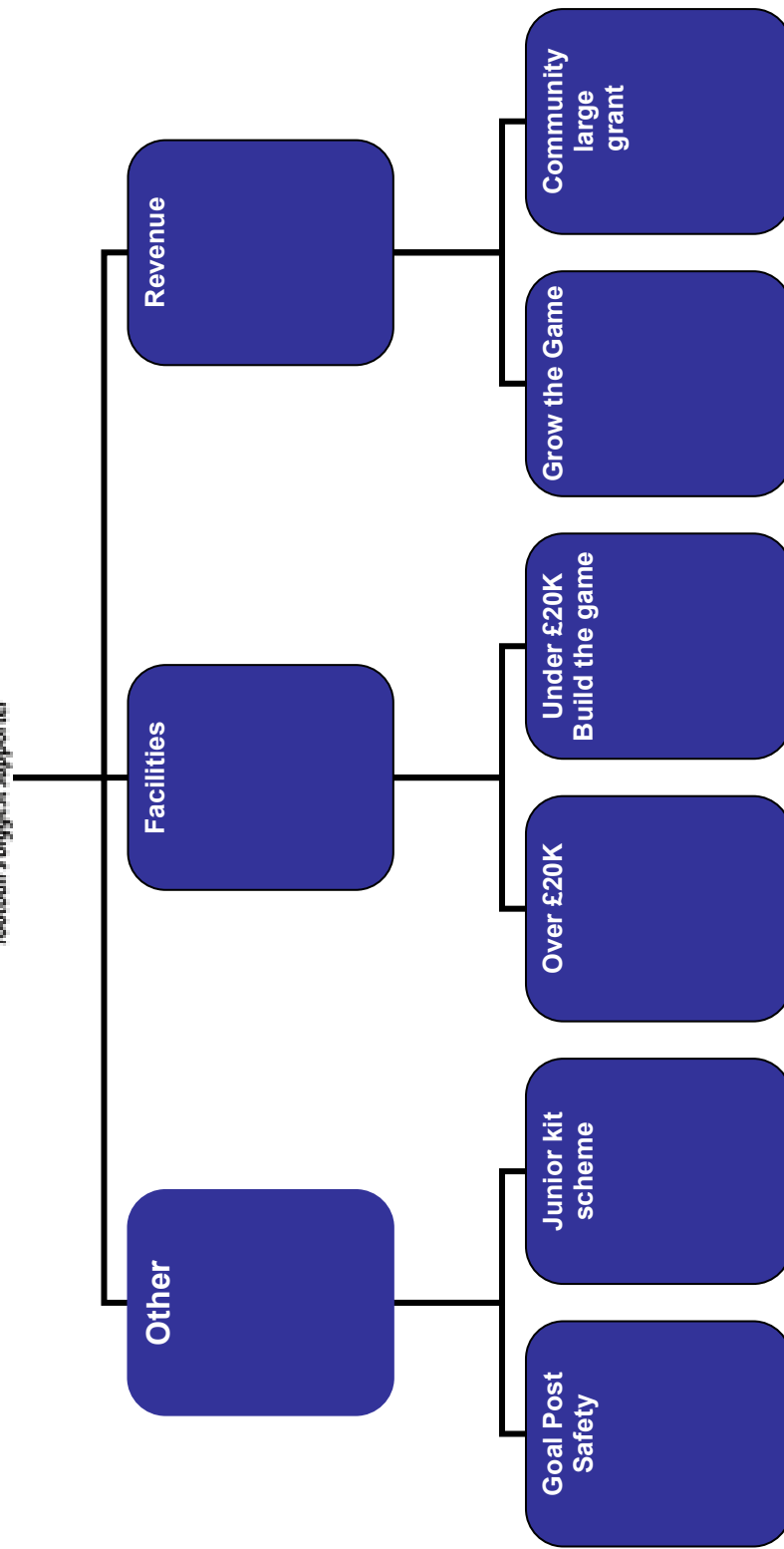

Schemes

Small Grants

- Grants of between £300 and £10,000 will be provided to support sport in communities. The total project cost should not exceed £50,000 The application and award processes will be as streamlined as possible. (Nationally £7m Lottery)
- How to apply? online
- Project duration 12 months
- Aims: Projects must seek to increase participation in sport, sustain participation in sport or provide opportunities to excel at a chosen sport.

Sportsmatch

Increases investment in community sport by matching new sponsorship money pound for pound.

- Grants of between £500 and £100,000 will be provided to clubs
- Timescales: October 2009, they will be accepting applications for projects that would spend Sportsmatch funding after 1 April 2010. Final funding decisions regarding these projects will be made in late March 2010.
