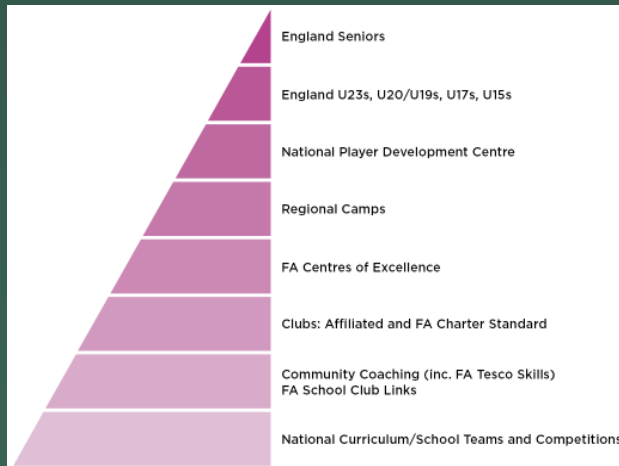


What is the Plymouth Argyle Girls Centre of Excellence?

The Centre of Excellence is supported by the Football Association. It provides young females players throughout Devon and surrounding areas an opportunity to progress in Football.

The Plymouth Argyle Girls Centre of Excellence compete in the South West fixture programme against Bristol Academy, Cornwall FA, Dorset FA Gloucestershire FA, Somerset FA and Wiltshire FA. This ensures high quality competitive opportunities on a regular basis. There are opportunities to attend regional talent camps. England Scouts regularly visit games to ensure Devon's talented girls are given every opportunity to move up the Female Football Development Pathway (see below).



What does the Plymouth Argyle Centre of Excellence provide?

The Girls Centre of Excellence provides high quality coaching from FA Qualified Level 2/3 coaches. The programme is overseen by a UEFA licensed director.

This is the only FA Centre of Excellence in Devon, the centre attracts talented female players from as far North as Bideford, East as Tiverton, South as Torquay, and as West as Liskeard. It is the pinnacle of players in the area, and offers the best opportunities' to progress into international football.

Who can be involved?

The Centre runs at the U10, U12, U14 and U16 age groups. We are therefore looking for players from school years 3 to 10 (School Year 2009/2010). Player who have played competitive football before will obviously have an advantage, however we are keen to see players who have no competitive football experience who are talented in other sports.

How does it work?

The trials will be held in two different stages (phase 1 and phase 2). The following format is to be applied:

Phase 1:

Open trials on the dates included with this leaflet. Session content will include basic football technique, and match play. There will be no decision on who has made the next stage. Players from 2009/2010 season will not be involved in this section of the trials. All players will be informed if they are successful within 3 working days of their trial. All players will receive individual feedback

Phase 2:

Phase 2 will include all those successful from Phase 1, along with the squad members from the 2009/2010 season. Sessions will be lead by the respective head coaches. The focus will be game related. Analysis will be undertaken on completion of the trials and all trialists will be written to in due course.
