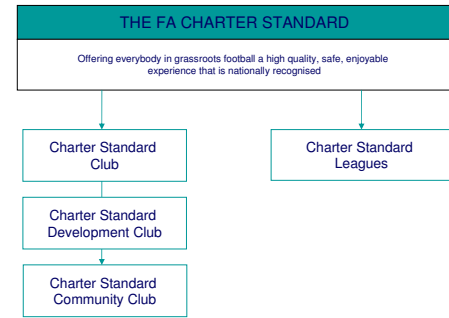

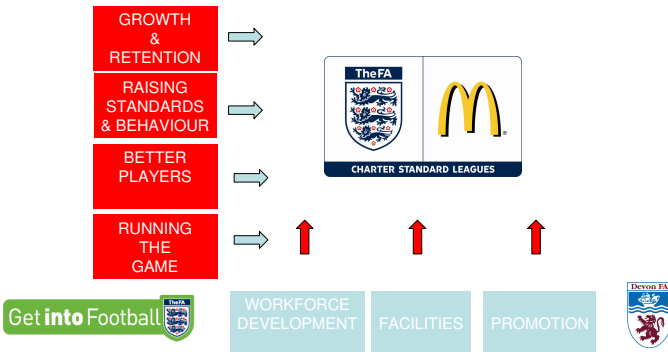

Charter Standard Leagues

- Kite Mark award for Leagues – deliver CS Vision
 - Offering everybody in grassroots football a high quality, safe, enjoyable experience, that is Nationally recognised
- 4 leagues are working towards in Devon
 - Others are interested



Change in Criteria

- CS was updated on 1st July 2009
- All clubs will have received the information
 - Brings the CS Programme in line with the National Game Strategy
 - FA Target - 75% of Youth Football by 2012
- RESPECT & New Age Appropriate Coaching Courses
- Annual Health Check



What does this mean for your club?

- Need to be aware of the changes
- Work towards any part that you do not meet
- Prepare for the Health Check when you affiliate
- New forms to progress through awards



Annual Health Check

- When?
 - Affiliation time 2010/11
- How?
 - Similar form as for existing renewals
 - Coach Tracking Matrix
 - Club Safeguarding Children Report (CSCR)
 - Copies of Certificates? (Only if not shown on CSCR)
 - National Database (County FA use & club use?)



Charter Standard Working Party

- Established – early 2009
- Part of the CS sign off Process (new clubs)
- Part of the discipline process (existing & new)
 - Stage 1, 2 & 3 – bring in clubs to discuss behaviour
- Spot Checks
 - Undertake
 - Review

 - Richard Pallot
- Points

- Spot Checks
- League Feedback



Stages

- Stage 1
 - Action plan to address behaviour
- Stage 2
 - Potential to suspend CS award – 3 to 12 months
- Stage 3
 - CS Award removed for 12 months
