Members' Services is a new online facility being offered by County Football Associations and The Football Association. It's free to all affiliated leagues, clubs, referees and coaches.


Our aim is to provide online information to leagues, clubs, referees and coaches giving them access to their football, reducing the administrative burden for them, and giving them up-to-date information instantly, whenever they need it.

How Do I Get to Members' Services?

Members' Services are available from any County FA website, via the Members link. You'll need to know your FA Number (FAN, which used to be referred to as an NPD) and you'll need to get a password, which can be obtained automatically from the FA systems.

Who Can Use Members' Services?

At present Members' Services is available to the following people:Leagues – Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer
Clubs – Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer
Referees – All Registered referees
Coaches – All coaches



- If it is your first time using member services, you may need to **Request Access** using the menu on the left
- Click on the Club Official menu item on the left hand side
- Enter your FAN and, Club ID and Affiliation Number in the spaces provided and click Submit
- Your login details will then be emailed to the specified email address

My Football Section

Clicking on the My Football Section will highlight the clubs where you have been appointed as a Club Official.

- To identify the linked sections of the club click on the club you wish to access to view
- The list of linked clubs is then displayed at the bottom of the Club homepage
- Club Secretaries, Treasurers, Chairmen, Charter Standard Co-ordinators,
 Volunteer Co-ordinators and Club Officials have the ability to add other Club Officials to their club records.

Editing & Adding Club Volunteers/Officials

Select a role from the **drop down list**

Click on the **My Football** menu item on the left hand menu Click on the **Club Menu** item for the club you wish to access Click on the **Club Officials** menu item Click the **Add Contact** menu item to add new contacts

There are 3 ways to find an individual you wish to add:

- Select an individual who is already attached to your club (as a player, club official, coach etc) from the Select individual drop down list
- o Search for individuals using their FAN and date of birth
- o Search for individuals using their FA CRC number and date of birth
- Once you find the correct individual, click Save at the top of your pop up window to add your club contacts

If you wish to remove an individual click **Remove**.
